

Strive Living Society is a non-profit registered charity which endeavors to design and deliver community living services, tailored to each individual we support. Strive Living Society offers residential and community integration services throughout Southwestern BC for children, youth, adults, and seniors since 1988.

Liberty Place houses 20 tenants in an apartment building style Assisted Living facility for adults with physical disabilities, such as Spinal Cord Injury, Multiple Sclerosis, Muscular Dystrophy, Spina Bifida, and Cerebral Palsy. All tenants are in power chairs or manual wheel chairs and range in age from 20 to 70. The Recreation department offers various recreation programs ranging from board games to outings to and one-on-one assistance.

Volunteers help with programs on site, assist tenants on recreation outings and provide one-on-one assistance, such as help declutter/organize their home, play board games, or help with paper work.
