Tips for Completing Your Online Entrance Awards Application

- You must have a Douglas College student number to apply for an entrance award.
- Your application is not complete until you answer **all** questions **including** “Yes” to the declaration.
- If you want to make any changes to your application you can do so up until midnight on **April 1**.
- Once you have completed and submitted your application, the next screen will tell you if you have successfully completed your application.
NOTE: If you are ever unsure if your application has been submitted, check the Award Application page where the “Entrance Award Application” link is and it will tell you if your application has been submitted successfully.
- Your application must be submitted by **April 1**.
- Submit your high school transcript, your reference letters and any other supporting documentation to the financial aid office at Douglas College by **April 3**.

No late applications will be accepted.

Checklist

- Your online application is complete and you have confirmed that it has been submitted

You have forwarded the following to the financial aid office at Douglas College:

- An official high school transcript showing final grades for grade 11 and year to date marks for grade 12
- Reference letters providing evidence of volunteer/participation in school or community activities

In addition to these items, if you are wishing to be considered for Entrance Awards please include:

- A letter outlining your personal and/or family financial circumstances and why you feel you should be considered for an award.
- A reference letter from a high school counsellor attesting to your financial need.
