

Online Autism Outreach Training

Created in partnership with the BC Ministry of Children and Family Development, the training is open to anyone:

- working with a child diagnosed with Autism under a plan created by a professional,
- living in British Columbia,
- able to commit to 14 weeks of fully on-line courses

The training consists of two college level courses:

- Teaching and Learning Foundations
- Behaviour Intervention Lab

The course are taught by board-certified BACB® Behavior Analysts. They are worth 6 credits which can be applied to the Douglas College Behaviour Intervention Certificate program. The cost is \$300 plus textbook (approximately \$90).

Session 1: September to December 2020

Session 2: January to April 2021
