*Fall 2019 applicants intending to use Summer 2019 courses in their evaluation, must indicate a post-secondary completion date of August 31st 2019 in the "Academic History" section of their EducationPlannerBC application.

Repeated Courses

Students may repeat a maximum of 2 of the 8 required courses used for admission. If a student has repeated more than 2 required courses, we will use the best 2 courses in the GPA calculation and the first attempt's grade for each subsequent repeated course.

If a student has completed more than one of the listed ENGL/PHIL/WL courses, we will use the highest grade (this is not counted as a repeat).
