- Enrollment in UBC Faculty of Arts
- Completion of at least 54 credits which must include (see below):
  - (i) 6 credits of Economics
  - (ii) 6 credits of calculus equivalent to MATH 104 & MATH 105;
  - (iii) 3 credits that satisfy the writing component
  - (iv) 6 credits of second- or third-year level courses in economics
- Competitive GPA (see FAQ) on all 54 credits (12 may be removed)
