



UBC Admission Requirements:

- UBC’s [English Language competency requirement](#)
- Minimum of 24 transferrable credits (to maximum of 60 credits).
- Admission GPA - [The Faculty of Arts](#), minimum average has been 3.2 to 3.4 (on a 4.33 scale), calculated on the most recent 30 credits

Department of International Relations admission requirements:

2-step application process: [Apply to UBC](#), select the Faculty of Arts as their program option, and then work on meeting the [pre-requisites for the IR major](#) and apply to the International Relations major.

- Separate [application](#) and deadline date
- Current enrollment in UBC Faculty of Arts
- Completion of at least 54 credits
- Completion of at least one of the courses indicated below (strongly recommended that students complete them all)
- Competitive GPA (usually 76-80%)
