UBC Faculty of Medicine - MD undergraduate program admission requirements:

Minimum academic percentile – 75%/ competitive – 80+ %.
90 university-transferable credits - AP, IB and A Level credits cannot count towards the 90 minimum
credits. (Part-time course loads require additional rationale)
ONE set of official transcripts from ALL post-secondary institutions attended
6 credits of English coursework by April 30 of the year of entry into medical school -English Courses Chart
Recommended Courses - biology, chemistry and biochemistry are strongly recommended
Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT) - request that their results be sent electronically to UBC
