



**UBC Admission requirements:**

- UBC’s [English Language competency requirement](#)

**Bachelor of [Commerce Admission Requirements](#):**

- Minimum of 24 transferrable credits (to maximum of 60 credits) for admission to year 2
- Minimum of 48 transferrable credits (to maximum of 60 credits) for admission to year 3
- Minimum GPA required for admission is 2.50 (calculated on the last 30 credits). Core courses must have an average of 2.50 (minimum) and all attempts are used in the calculation of your core average.
- Note: meeting minimum GPA does not guarantee admission**
- Completion of UBC Core courses for year 2 and / or 3
- [Personal Profile](#), which includes a video interview, at the time of application.
- [UBC online application](#): submit by **January 15 of the application year**.

**Note:** COMM 29x courses are prerequisites for third year courses. To be eligible for the Accounting or Finance option, you must have all option prerequisite courses completed by April of admission year. Look at UBC’s academic calendar for [Degree requirements](#).
