



## MCFD Sponsored On-line Autism Outreach Training: Admission Criteria

Please carefully read the criteria below to determine if you are eligible and ready for this learning opportunity. Your application package should include three documents: 1) application form, 2) a reference letter for proof of BI employment/volunteer or if you are a family member the reference letter can come from a professional on your team, 3) this criteria list with all checkboxes marked and signed at the bottom. Once received, the DACS department will submit all of your documents to the Douglas College Registrar's Office on your behalf.

- You understand that the cost for this session will be \$300.00 (plus \$90.00 for the textbook) which includes the application fee and that you will pay once you have received your student number and registered in your courses. Payment must be made by cheque, on-line banking or on-line Interac;
- You live in British Columbia;
- You work with a child or youth who has an ASD diagnosis and a formal behaviour plan or you are a family member of a child or youth who has an ASD diagnosis and a formal behaviour plan;
- The child's current behaviour plan of intervention that was developed by a professional (Behaviour Consultant, Speech Language Pathologist, Occupational Therapist, Resource Teacher, etc);
- You have the child's parents and if applicable, your work site's permission to talk about/video tape some portions of your work (consent forms will follow). This information is about your practice, not the child, family or related professionals, it will only be shared within the course and confidentiality agreements will apply;
- You have the time available to take the two course package. These courses are actual first year post-secondary credit courses. This will require connecting to a Blackboard 9 Learning Management System via the internet at least twice a week, plus a number of hours of study and practice time per week;
- You will be available for every other week 'virtual' meetings via Collaborate for your lab course. These are typically scheduled on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday;
- You have access to high speed internet (dial up internet will cause some issues; please let us know if this is your only option and we will adjust accordingly)
- You have access to videotaping equipment (video recorder, smart phone, laptop with camera, etc) and agree to check your email at least twice a week for messages from Douglas College;
- You will arrange to purchase or borrow the required textbooks for the DACS 1150 course (approximately \$90) before week two of the course. The DACS 1341 does not require a text;
- You will attend the "real time" online orientation session for Collaborate and Blackboard technologies (date TBA). If you are unable to attend, you understand that it will be your responsibility to make sure you know how to access and use the technology systems.
