✓ **Election Platform Statement**-Each nominee **will** be required to supply a brief platform statement of no more than 250 words which will be posted on the Education Council election website.

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS – A by-election is being conducted to fill ONE (1) student position on Education Council. There are four (4) student positions on Education Council, three positions were filled in earlier elections.

Under the College and Institutes Act a **student** is defined as;

"a person the Registrar recognizes to be enrolled and in good standing in a course or program of studies at the institution." Students who are registered in a **minimum of 1 credit course** are eligible to be nominated and to co-sign a nomination form.

Students will elect **ONE (1)** representative to the Education Council who will serve for the term ending August 31, 2021 and may be elected to two (2) additional consecutive terms. The student representatives will be elected from the students at large.

- ✓ A student from the Coquitlam campus is defined as registered in 50% of their courses offered at the Coquitlam campus.
- ✓ A student from the New Westminster campus is defined as registered in 50% of their courses offered at the New Westminster campus.

Nomination Requirements-Each nomination form must include:

- ✓ The name of the nominee, campus, address, email, phone and student number.
- ✓ Nominees must submit fifteen (15) forms, (one from each nominator) in one (1) email to Mary Cope, Admin Officer at copem@douglascollege.ca by 4:00pm on Monday-October 5, 2020. Do not send fifteen (15) separate emails. Emailed nomination forms should be marked: Attention: Education Council By-Election Student Representative.
- ✓ The signature of the nominee indicating that the nominee has read the statement on the nomination form and is willing to run for by-election.
