Plans, implements, and evaluates recreation programming for residents. Provides assessments, care planning and reporting on resident participation and progress. Attends and documents participation for care conferences. Works with team to ensure timely implementation of resident and calendar driven interventions including 1:1 visits, LTS Model interventions, and group programming. Works with volunteers assigned to specific programs and follows general job routine and responsibilities assigned to this line.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Education, Training and Experience

Diploma or degree in therapeutic recreation (preferred) or recognized related program and experience working with seniors/individuals living with dementia, mental illness or dual diagnoses. Minimum two years' experience in recreation preferred.

Ability to work independently and collaborate with others effectively, organize work and operate related equipment.
