This includes but is not limited to developing programs that promote vocational skills, and social/leisure activities, which provide empowerment of and promotes independence within its members.

- Post-Secondary Education in the Mental Health Discipline (degree or two year diploma)
- Minimum of two years' experience working with persons whom have a chronic and persistent psychiatric illness
- Experience in social group work, recreation, life skills, and Psychosocial Rehabilitation

- Proven ability to organize and prioritize multiple demands;
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Ability to work as part of a team and practice the Team Approach.
- Demonstrated knowledge of client outcome measurement, client information management, and client file management.
- Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of the socio-economic and cultural background of the service population.
- Must be able to efficiently and effectively manage work time and energy and stress levels.
