

Bob Bearpark Foundation Coaching Award Douglas College Sport Science Department

The Bob Bearpark Foundation has been established to further coaching education in British Columbia. The Foundation is named in memory of Bob Bearpark who was a coach and provincial government administrator in BC and architected the coaching development system in this province. Winners will exhibit a commitment to coaching education, demonstrate a positive involvement in community sport, and be in good academic standing in their respective program. To be eligible for this award, the student must:

- a) Be a student in the Sport Science Diploma or Bachelor of Physical Education and Coaching Programs;
- b) Be enrolled in a minimum of 9 (nine) credits in the academic year;
- c) Have a minimum GPA of 2.0; and
- d) Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee.

The following awards will be disbursed:

- 1. **Two (2) \$1,000 awards,** chosen from BPEC **or** Sport Science Diploma program students.
- 2. **Three (3) \$500 awards,** chosen from BPEC program students only.
 - 1. One to a 2nd year student (i.e., has completed 30 or fewer credits), one to a 3rd year student (i.e., has completed 30-90 credits) and one to a 4th year student (i.e., has completed more than 90 credits).
