This scholarship was established by Susan Diewert Kwong and Peter Kwong in memory of Susan's late husband, Dr. Gordon L. Diewert, who was tragically killed, at the age of 30, when an impaired driver collided with his vehicle on April 28, 1981. Susan worked at Douglas College from 1970 to 1973. The purpose of this fund is to recognize and provide financial assistance to any student enrolled in the Sport Science Diploma or Physical Education & Coaching Degree program, or Student Athlete in any program, who have volunteer or work experience, either in their community or at the College, focused on the prevention of alcohol abuse and/or drinking and driving accompanied with strong academic performance (GPA of 3.5 or above required).
