- 2. Have completed an Associate of Arts degree (or 60-credit diploma equivalent) with a specialization in English or Creative Writing OR have completed a combined minimum of six English and/or Creative Writing courses; and
- 3. Be accepted as a transfer student from Douglas College into a Bachelor of Arts program in English or Bachelor of Fine Arts Program in Creative Writing
- 4. Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee
