- a) Be a student in the Sport Science Diploma or Bachelor of Physical Education and Coaching Programs;
- b) Completed/ be enrolled in (and have passed) a minimum of 24 credits in the academic year;
- c) Have a minimum GPA of 3.0.; and
- d) Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee.
