# **Application and Selection Process**

Deadlines: January 31 (Summer), May 31 (Fall), September 30 (Winter)

- To be eligible for consideration, applicants must have already applied to Douglas College and have a Student ID number (e.g. 300xxxxxx).
- Submit the application form and all supporting documents as indicated above by email to dciadmissions@douglascollege.ca before the scholarship application deadline.
- Students are selected based on their previous academic performance and their engagement in their school, community and/or personal development.
- Successful recipients will be notified of their scholarship by email at the beginning of their first semester at Douglas College. The scholarship will be issued to the recipients by cheque. Scholarships are non-transferable.
