Application and Selection Process

Deadlines: January 31 (Summer), May 31 (Fall), September 30 (Winter)

- Submit the application form and all supporting documents as indicated above by email to dciamissions@douglascollege.ca.
- Students are selected based on their previous academic performance and their engagement in their school, community and/or personal development.
- Successful recipients will be notified of their award by email prior to arrival at Douglas College. The scholarship will be applied to the recipient's student account and will be redeemable towards the 2nd semester's tuition fees. Scholarships are non-refundable and non-transferable.
