

To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this document as the official and general definitions of Douglas College's (DLI #O19360973702) Academic Calendar for immigration purposes. This will help clarify any concerns regarding the student's academic history.

Academic Semesters

Douglas College has three academic semesters per year:

- Fall semester: September – December
- Winter semester: January – April
- Summer semester: May – August

Level of Study

All programs offered to international students at Douglas College are at a post-secondary level.

Enrolment Status

- Full-time enrolment at Douglas College means registering **and** completing a minimum of 9 credits per academic semester. If a student withdraws or receives a [W, UN, UNW, FD, or AUD](#) the course will **not** count towards the full-time course load. As a clarification note, a grade of 'F' does not carry academic credits **but** counts towards the full-time course load of a student. Please refer to our [grading policy](#) for other grades that can count towards a full-time course load.

Scheduled Breaks

- Scheduled Breaks are defined as Study Breaks, Summer semesters, and the time between semesters from the day **after** the exam period until the day **before** the first day of classes of the next semester. Students are required to enroll in the semesters before **and** after the scheduled break.
- Summer semester is **not** a scheduled break if it is the student's first or last semester in the program.
- All Diplomas, Associate Degrees, Bachelor's Degrees, Post-Baccalaureate Diplomas and Early Childhood Education Certificate programs offered to international students are eligible for scheduled breaks.
- During a scheduled break (Summer semester), a student can take full-time studies, part-time studies, or a break from studies.
- Summer semester is **not** considered a scheduled break for Post-Degree Diplomas and Certificate programs (excluding the Early Childhood Education Certificate program).
