#### AIP versus Study Permit Approval

- AIP: The approval in principle is a letter from IRCC stating that the study permit eligibility requirements have been met, but medical, security and biometrics still need to be reviewed. You are not able to travel to Canada yet.
- Study Permit Approval: The study permit is a document that allows <u>foreign nationals</u> to study at <u>designated learning</u> <u>institutions</u> (DLI) in Canada. Most foreign nationals need a study permit to study in Canada. Make sure you have all the documents you need before you apply. You should apply **before you travel to Canada**.
- Your study permit is not a visa. It doesn't let you enter Canada. You may also need a visitor visa or an electronic travel authorization (eTA).

#### Mandatory New Student Survey
