Full-Time & Scheduled Break

- Each institution defines full-time studies and scheduled breaks in compliance with IRCC.
- For immigration purpose, 9 credits/semester is considered full-time.
- PDD Students are advised to study all three semesters consecutively,
- PBD students may take summer semesters off, or be part-time in summer semesters.

Important Change to the Registration System!

First semester course registration is automatic provided by the international office

BUT...

- You are responsible for your own course registration for all future semesters.
- Registration slots are assigned based on GPA.

MyAccount > Registration > Check Registration Date & Time > Select Term and Continue

You should register as soon as your registration opens at this date & time shown on your MyAccount!



BUSN 3380 - 3 Credits - Operations Management

This course will provide students with a generalized approach to designing, operating, and improving the activities of service and manufacturing businesses. Students will compare theory with actual operating businesses, and develop solutions to real-world problems. Topics include: flowcharting, processes, quality, forecasting, capacity planning, layout and job design, inventory systems, scheduling, and supply chain management. (Recommended that students have taken BUSN 2429 or other statistics course.)




Step 4: Build your schedule Step 5: Register on MyAccount at your registration date & time





MyPath Overview

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Decide the 2nd program

- Check the program page
- Think about your career plan

Know if there are overlaps

- Check the program page
- Find out the substitutes
- Contact an Academic Advisor or Program Coordinator

Decide if you want a semester break

- Know working eligibility
- Talk to an ISA

Fill out a program declaration (COP) form

- Apply to graduate from the 1st PDD
- Submit COP by the 1st month in your last semester of the 1st PDD
- Receive a LOA through email later

^{*} No Auto-Enrollment for student you initially applied to two PDDs.



Transfer Credits

- You must complete the full 30 credits of PDD or 60 credits of PBD
- No course work can be waived from your undergraduate degree.
 Substitution is possible where equivalent course is granted.
- Transfer credits from institutions outside BC may requires two copies of course outline for each course. The process takes 2 to 3 months.



Transferring credits from another school

- From BC Post-Secondary institutions
 - Submit Transfer Credits Request (TCR) form & official transcript to Enrollment Service's Office
 - Processing time is about 8 weeks
- From Canadian Post-Secondary institutions outside of BC
 - Submit TCR & official transcript to Enrollment Service's Office
 - Plus two copies of course outlines for each course from the time period attended
- From outside Canada
 - Attention: if you do not complete all of your coursework within Canada, it will show up your Graduation Letter. This might affect the length of the PGWP you will receive (not applicable to students who start their studies from outside Canada due to the COVID and the current policy is until December 31, 2021).
 - Submit TCR & official transcript in English
 - Plus two copies of course outlines for each course in English from the time period attended
