

Sport Science Undergraduate Council Learning Opportunities Award

The Sport Science Undergraduate Council Learning Opportunities Award was established, in 2009, by the Sport Science Faculty through a donation of Prior Learning and Assessment Recognition (PLAR) fees and Student Council fundraising. The purpose of this award is to support students in their professional development. Examples include, but are not limited to, conferences, workshops, experiential education opportunities, and professional memberships. Students enrolled in either the Sport Science Diploma or Physical Education and Coaching Degree programs are eligible to apply. This award is administered on an ongoing basis, on a first come, first served. To be eligible for this award, the student must:

- a) Be a student in the Sport Science Diploma or Bachelor of Physical Education and Coaching Programs;
- b) Be enrolled in a minimum of 9 (nine) credits in the academic year;
- c) Have a minimum GPA of 2.0; and
- d) Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee.
