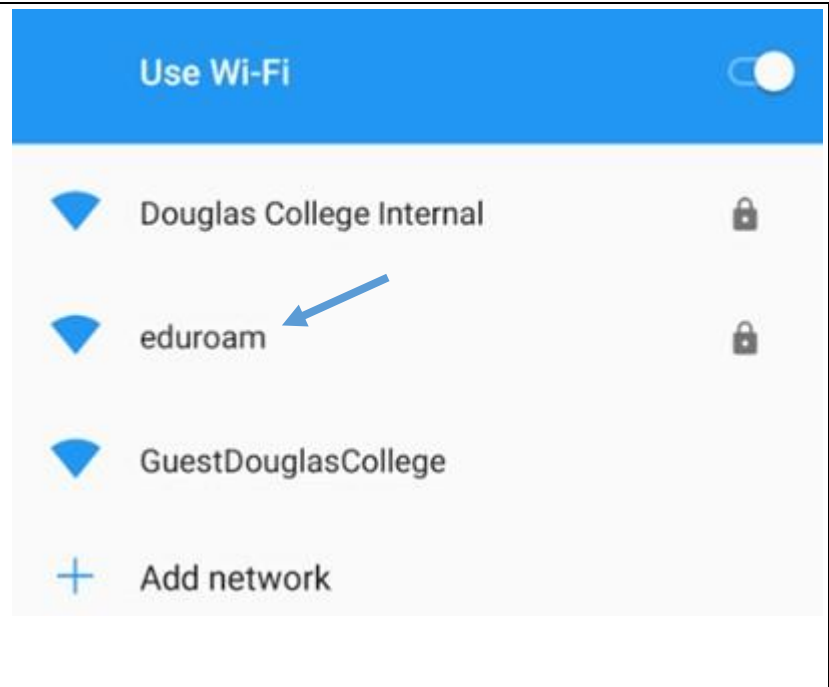





Android 11 - Connection Walkthrough


- Android 11 devices must use the eduroam Wi-Fi option to connect to campus Wi-Fi.
- First download the installer on your device here: <https://cat.eduroam.org/>
- Select Douglas College
- Select your OS
