Honorary Fellow

Sarah McLachlan

With more than 40 million albums sold worldwide, Sarah McLachlan is a multi-platinum singer-songwriter known for her intimate vocals and emotionally resonant lyrics. Over the course of her career, she has received three Grammy Awards and 12 Juno Awards, and she has been inducted into both the Canadian Music Hall of Fame and the Canadian Songwriters Hall of Fame.

A lifelong musician, Sarah began studying voice, classical piano and guitar at a young age. Discovered by Nettwerk Records at just 17, she launched her professional music career in Vancouver at 19. She has released nine studio albums, earning wide recognition as a Canadian cultural icon. In 1997, Sarah also founded the Lilith Fair tour, showcasing female artists and raising more than \$7 million for women's charities. Among her many honours, she is an Officer of the Order of Canada, a member of the Order of British Columbia and a recipient of the Governor General's Performing Arts Award for Lifetime Achievement.

Now more than 30 years into her career, Sarah is dedicated to making access to music education more inclusive for children and youth facing barriers to participation through the Sarah McLachlan School of Music. Today, the not-for-profit school serves over 1,200 students, providing top-quality music instruction and mentorship at no cost in Vancouver and Edmonton. With Sarah covering all the school's administrative costs, all money raised goes directly toward supporting these students.

Sarah McLachlan will be awarded the Douglas College Honorary Fellow Medal during the 2pm graduation ceremony on June 17.

Governor General's Collegiate Bronze Medal

For nearly 150 years, the Governor General's Academic Medals have recognized the outstanding scholastic achievements of post-secondary students in Canada. The Collegiate Bronze Medal is awarded annually on behalf of the Governor General to a graduating student with the highest overall grade point average.

Lieutenant Governor's Medal for Inclusion, Democracy and Reconciliation

The Lieutenant Governor's medal program was established in 1979 to recognize students enrolled in public post-secondary institutions in British Columbia who have made outstanding contributions to the promotion of inclusion, democracy and/or reconciliation within their campus community.

Graduation distinction and valedictorians

Graduation distinctions are recognized with the presentation of a gold honour cord. Students awarded the graduation distinction are students who have achieved a minimum GPA of 3.67 in the qualifying courses for their credential. Eligible students are noted with an asterisk. Valedictorians are high-achieving students chosen by their faculties, generally from the highest-level credential.

Academic regalia

Graduates, faculty and those participating in the stage party wear academic regalia consisting of a gown, sash or hood, and a hat called a mortar board. Academic regalia has been the traditional costume worn by graduates for centuries at universities and colleges, and while it historically served the practical purpose of keeping graduates warm and dry in inclement weather, today's regalia is a celebration of academic achievement. Different-coloured hoods, sashes and mortar boards represent the type of credential received by a graduate and the institution they attended.

At Douglas College, graduates wear a black robe, and a cap with a black tassel and yellow gold charm. The tassel symbolizes their transition from student to graduate.

Regalia for students receiving a Bachelor's Degree, Post-Degree Diploma, Post-Baccalaureate Diploma, or Graduate Diploma also includes a coloured hood:

Bachelor of Arts, Applied Criminology – white with gold piping

Bachelor of Arts, Applied Psychology – white with gold piping

Bachelor of Arts, Child and Youth Care – white with red piping

Bachelor of Business Administration – light grey

Bachelor of Physical Education and Coaching – palmetto

Bachelor of Science, Nursing – apricot

Bachelor of Science, Psychiatric Nursing – apricot

Bachelor of Social Work – chamois

Bachelor of Therapeutic Recreation – salmon

Graduate Diploma – black with silver piping

Post-Baccalaureate Diploma – black with silver piping

Post-Degree Diploma – black with silver piping

Regalia for students receiving a Diploma, Certificate or Advanced Certificate includes a steel-grey stole.

Indigenous graduates may wear a red stole with the College's ceremonial badge embroidered on a red sash. The badge, designed by Stó:lō artist Carrielynn Victor, is a heraldic emblem and was unveiled alongside a coat of arms as part of the College's 50th anniversary celebrations in 2019. The badge includes a raven, fir boughs and hearts. The raven was chosen because it is a curious and intelligent bird, and because of its connection to local Coast Salish Indigenous cultures. The boughs are Douglas fir and are local to the area. The heart is a feature of Scottish coats of arms used by people named Douglas and alludes to the College's namesake, Sir James Douglas. The heart also embodies the College's philosophy: "Do what you love. Be good at it."

Credentials awarded at Douglas College

Douglas College awards credentials commensurate with requirements necessary at the time of program completion. All credentials are awarded through Enrolment Services once it is determined that candidates satisfy program requirements. The types of credentials are typically defined by the length of study and the number of required credits in a defined program of study.

Advanced Certificate: A defined program of study with a minimum of 30 credits of specialized courses.

Associate Degree: A program of study consistent with provincial legislation with a minimum of 60 credits of first- and second-year university-transfer courses.

Bachelor's Degree: A program of study consistent with provincial legislation with a minimum of 120 credits in a defined program of study, including a minimum of 45 upper-level credits. A bachelor's degree will include an honours or major, and may include a minor and/or concentration.

Certificate: A program of study with a minimum of 15 credits.

Continuing Education Certificate of Completion: Issued when formal recognition of successful completion of a non-credit program is required.

Diploma: A defined program of study with a minimum of 60 credits; may include a specialization with 18 or more credits of thematically linked courses.

Graduate Diploma: A program of study with a minimum of 30 credits of coursework at the 5000 level, and requires a minimum entrance requirement of a bachelor's degree.

Honours: A primary area of study that is composed of 45 upper-level credits in the area of study, with a minimum program GPA of 3.33. Honours study may include guided studies, supervised research and/or a major paper.

Post-Baccalaureate Diploma: A program of study with a minimum of 60 credits, including a minimum of 30 credits of upper-level courses, and requires a minimum entrance requirement of a bachelor's degree.

Post-Degree Diploma: A program of study with a minimum of 30 credits, including a minimum of 15 credits of upper-level courses, and requires a minimum entrance requirement of a bachelor's degree.

Training Group Certificate of Completion: Issued when a formal credential of successful completion for a Training Group non-credit program is required.
