Autism CanTech! is an innovative program for Autistic youth between the ages of 18-30 who want to work in the computer and technology sectors. The fully federally funded program includes one semester course at the Douglas College New Westminister campus that prepares participants for a two-month work experience at course completion.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Get one-to-one support from a career coach who will work with you to ensure training and workplace success.
- Learn skills such as use of communication and productivity platforms, process management, digital literacy, data processing and teamwork.
- Get the opportunity to work with diverse companies within the digital economy.
- Learn how to search for work in the tech sector and build resumes and cover letters that work.
- Connect with other autistic youth.
- Obtain a two-month paid work placement and the opportunity for full-time employment.
- Learn how to use innovative new assistive technology.
- Attend classes either morning or afternoon at the Douglas College New Westminister Campus.

- Diagnosed or self-diagnosed as Autistic
- Between the ages of 18-30
- Citizen or permanent resident of Canada
- Legally able to work in Canada
- Confident using a PC and various software such as Microsoft
- Able to communicate independently
