#### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Work Experience Study is the final requirement for students wishing to complete the Skills for Success Practitioner (SFSP) CE Certificate Program.

Learners complete a minimum of 35 hours work experience to apply the concepts taught in the Skills for Success Practitioner program (volunteer or paid work).

Learners are coached by a Skills for Success Instructor during the work experience and supported to complete the final assignment. Successful completion is based on a grading rubric that outlines the requirements to receive a ‘Mastery’ grade.
