## **LINC Application Instructions**

(British Columbia - Lower Mainland)

- 1. Complete the application form on the other side.
- 2. Photocopy your latest immigration document (one of the following):
  - a) Permanent Resident Card (photocopy both sides of the card)
  - b) Confirmation of Permanent Residence (form IMM5292)
  - c) Record of Landing (form IMM1000 issued prior to June 2002)
  - d) Notice of Decision from the Refugee Protection Division of the Immigration and Refugee Board (IRB) confirming refugee status
  - e) Letter from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) giving approval to remain in Canada while your application for permanent residence is being finalized
- 3. Mail, fax or bring the completed application form <u>and</u> the photocopy of your immigration document to one of the following offices:
- a) If you live in Vancouver, North Vancouver, West Vancouver, Richmond, South Delta, Burnaby or New Westminster:

Please telephone the assessment centre office if you change your address. After we receive your application we will give or mail you a letter with the assessment appointment date and time. After your assessment we will mail you the test results. You may then go to any LINC school to register for class or come back to the assessment centre for information on available class times, locations and wait lists (no appointment necessary). The LINC assessment centre provides assessment services only for those who apply for and are eligible for the LINC program. The test results are valid for 1 year and you may not take the test more than one time per year.
